



## Occasional Paper Series Criteria for Paper Selection

The Center for International & Development Education (CIDE) is announcing an ongoing call for papers for its online Occasional Paper Series. CIDE is looking for studies that successfully accomplish the following eight criteria:

- 1) Capture the evolution and complexity of a given educational situation and explicitly utilize an analytical/theoretical framework
- 2) Go beyond mere description of current conditions, devoid of historical analysis of content or context and contextualize a given educational phenomenon, showing the dynamics and processes characterizing it
- 3) Problematize a phenomenon rather than merely map its features and show the connections between individual educational lives and meso and macro levels of social action
- 4) Acknowledge both the politics and the political nature of education and examine them systematically
- 5) Explore the processes of meaning-making in international and comparative education
- 6) Satisfy technical requirements of a recognized writing and format style and exhibit a logical and meaningful flow to the argument

Submissions must be made as Microsoft Word attachments and emailed to CIDE at [cide@ucla.edu](mailto:cide@ucla.edu). Please make sure that your draft:

- Includes an abstract of no more than 200 words
- Has been edited for grammatical and spelling errors
- Has numbered pages
- Is 10-25 pages in length
